## **OIL SANDS INFORMATION BULLETIN 2010-10**

### **Subject: Operator's Forecast Report Update**

Section 37 of the *Oil Sands Royalty Regulation, 2009* requires the Operator of an Oil Sands Project to file with the Department an Operator's Forecast Report relating to the current calendar year and subsequent 9 calendar years. The submission deadline is December 15, 2010.

Please note the following minor changes have been made to this year's Operator's Forecast Report:

1. Under "Production Volumes", changed product quality of API gravity to Density in kg/m<sup>3</sup>,
2. Updated explanatory notes,
3. Added "History of Revisions" tab.

The updated [Operator's Forecast Report](#) is available on Alberta Energy's Oil Sands website in Excel format. From our main internet site <http://www.energy.gov.ab.ca>, navigate to "Our Business", then to "Oil Sands" and then "Forms". The Operator's Forecast Report must be submitted electronically in Excel format through the secure web application, Electronic Transfer System (ETS).

The Department may request the Operator to give a presentation on the submitted forecasts.

### **Electronic Transfer System (ETS)**

To receive access to the Electronic Transfer System, an ETS account Set Up / Change Form must be submitted to the department. The majority of our clients have access to ETS with various permissions to provide information or request a service from the Department. However, their permissions need to be enhanced to include access to the Correspondence folder. This will allow you to submit the Operator's Forecast Report. Form naming conventions have been developed for the Operator's Forecast Report. When saving the form in Excel format you must use the following conventions:

OSR Project Number, Year, Report Name

Example: OSR015\_2010\_Operator's\_Forecast.xls
