## **MINERAL RIGHTS INFORMATION BULLETIN 2013-01**

### **SUBJECT: Mineral Assessment Reports Available Online**

Alberta mineral assessment reports are now being posted online and are available to be downloaded. They can be accessed at <http://www.energy.alberta.ca/minerals/3441.asp>.

#### Mineral Assessment Report Scanning Project

As the first phase of an ongoing project to make all mineral assessment reports freely available, Alberta Energy is in the process of scanning all mineral assessment reports on file. This process includes three parts:

1. Scanning – to convert the hard copy into a PDF.
2. Verification – to ensure the scanned version of the report is identical to the original hard copy.
3. Redaction – to ensure all private information is removed from all PDFs. This includes any personal and financial information that is not directly attributed to the assessment report.

Alberta Energy will be releasing batches of reports on the website, as they become available. The first set is now available.

Subsequent phases of this project will include the development of a searchable database of mineral assessment reports and other metallic and industrial mineral information in Alberta.
